MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY OF TUSCUMBIA
PUBLIC HEARING @ 5:02 P.M.
REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING HELD ON AUGUST 3, 2015

The Tusculmbia City Council met on Monday August 3, 2015 with Billy Shoemaker, Mayor, and Council Members Martha Smith, Robert Mitchell, George Johnson, Sr. Randall Davis and Richard Coates. JoAnn Armstead, City Clerk, Tom Heflin City Attorney, Department Head Joel Kendrick and Supervisor Greg Willingham (Public Works Department) were also present.

Mayor Billy Shoemaker opened the Public Hearing for the Re-Zoning of Property of Ronald Garner @5:02 p.m.

Mayor Billy Shoemaker called the regular scheduled meeting to order @5:30 p.m. Invocation was provided by Martha Smith, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Richard Coates.

Council Member Johnson made a motion to adopt the Minutes of July 20, 2015 (Regular Scheduled Meeting); seconded by Council Member Coates Motion Carried.

BUSINESS:

Stormwater Pollution Prevention Ordinance No. 15-0817A

Council Member Mitchell made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 15-0817A, an Ordinance to Establish a Stormwater Pollution Plan. The motion was seconded by Council Member Davis. Council Member Davis moved to carry the motion to adopt Ordinance No. 15-0817A over to the next meeting of the City Council which is scheduled for August 17, 2015. The motion was seconded by Council Member Smith and the motion to carry over to August 17, 2015 was unanimous.

Ordinance Amending Article V- Erosion and Settlement Control of Section 4 of the Code of Ordinances

Council Member Coates made the motion to adopt Ordinance No. 15-0817B, an Ordinance to Amend Article V – Erosion and Sediment Control of Section 4 Code of Ordinances of the City of Tusculmbia, Alabama. The motion was seconded by Council Member Johnson. Council Member Davis moved to carry the motion to adopt Ordinance No. 15-0817B over to the next regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council which is scheduled for August 17, 2015 and the motion was seconded by Council Member Smith. Motion to carry over to August 17, 2015 was unanimous.

Council Member Coates made the motion to “Adopt” Ordinance No. 15-0803C (rezoning of Blocks 2 & 8 and part of Block 9, Tusculmbia Center); seconded by Council Member Mitchell.

Upon Roll Call Vote the following is recorded: Randall Davis, Yes; George Johnson, Yes; Richard Coates, Yes; Billy Shoemaker, Yes; Martha Smith, Yes. Motion was unanimous.

Council Member Coates made the motion to declare a vacancy for a Laborer in the Parks and Recreation Department due to the promotion of Michael Hill. The motion was seconded by Council Member Johnson and the motion carried.

Council Member Mitchell made the motion to declare a vacancy for a Laborer in the Golf Department due to the promotion of Jerry Bunch. The motion was seconded by Council Member Smith and the motion carried.

The Kelley Group will provide a presentation on Stormwater on Wednesday, August 5, 2015. A Special Called Meeting will be posted to allow all council to attend.

Mr. Robert Stegall donated 2 ATV's to Park & Recreation Department valued at \$4,000.
