

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY OF TUSCUMBIA
REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING HELD ON DECEMBER 7, 2015

The Tuscumbia City Council met on December 7, 2015 with Billy Shoemaker, Mayor and Council Members Randall Davis, Richard Coates, George Johnson, Sr., Robert Mitchell and Martha Smith. JoAnn Armstead, City Clerk, Hal Hughton, Asst. City Attorney and Department Heads Anthony Logan, David Cole, Hugh Stanley, and Joel Kendrick, were also present.

Mayor Billy Shoemaker called the regular scheduled meeting to order @ 5:20 p.m. Invocation was provided by Martha Smith, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance that was led by Joel Kendrick.

Council Member Coates made the motion to adopt the Minutes of November 16, 2015 with Roll Call correction that exempted Council Member Mitchell from meeting (Regular Scheduled Meeting); seconded by Council Member Johnson. Motion Carried.

The Civil Service Board met on December 3, 2015 and hired James Ezekiel as a Fire Fighter for the City of Tuscumbia.

BUSINESS

Council Member Mitchell made the motion to approve the “2016 Weather Preparedness Tax Holiday” on February 26-28, 2016. The motion was seconded by Council Member Smith and the motion was unanimous.

Council Member Davis made the motion to approve the Solid Waste Management Plan, Resolution No. 15-012. The motion was seconded by Council Member Coates and the motion was unanimous.

Robbie Brown, owner of PoBoys Cajun Grill in Tuscumbia presented the Mayor and Council a marketing plan that could increase sales in Tuscumbia during the Christmas Holidays. Mr. Brown requested the City contribute \$1,000 toward advertising “Black Friday Rewind Sales Event” which is on December 18th and 19th. Council Member Mitchell made the motion to donate \$1,000 towards advertising which will help promote the City of Tuscumbia, subject to the approval of the City Attorney. The motion was seconded by Council Member Smith and the motion was unanimous.

OTHER

The Tuscumbia Retail Development presents “It’s a Dickens Christmas Y’all” Holiday Festival beginning on Friday December 11th thru Saturday December 12, 2015.

The Police Department’s Christmas Party is re-scheduled to Tuesday, December 15, 2015 at the Multi-Purpose Center.
