Residents of Coldwater Village met to discuss the maintaining of the grass area outside of the fence on Veterans Drive; the need for four-way stop signs on Veterans Drive and big trucks using Veterans Drive as a truck route. The council agreed to work on these issues.

Bo Stanley said they are moving right along with the crosswalks. They are ready to move north to 5th Street and Main Street with plans to begin pouring the concrete on Wednesday morning, January 18, 2017 if weather permits.

Chief Logan announced his officers have been issued body cameras. These cameras will provide an additional layer of safety for the officers. The body cameras were provided thru a grant administered by ADECA and approved by the last administration.

Mayor Underwood announced his plans to meet with the state tourism board on January 20, 2017 to see if a sports plex is possible to build on the land located behind Alabama Music Hall of Fame.
