MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY OF TUSCUMBIA
REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING HELD ON MARCH 16, 2015
@ 5:15 P.M.

The Tusculmbia City Council met on Monday March 16, 2015 @ 5:16 p.m. with Billy Shoemaker, Mayor, and Council Members Robert Mitchell, Randall Davis, Richard Coates, and George Johnson, Sr. JoAnn Armstead, City Clerk, Tom Heflin, City Attorney and Department Heads Anthony Logan and Sidney Nall were also present. Council Member Martha Smith was not available.

Mayor Billy Shoemaker called the meeting to order. Invocation was provided by Randall Davis, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Anthony Logan.

Council Member Johnson made a motion to adopt the Minutes of March 2, 2015 (Regular Scheduled Meeting); seconded by Council Member Davis. Motion Carried.

REPORTS OF BOARDS:

The Civil Service Board hired the following employees and their employment will begin immediately following their health screening and drug testing:

READINGS:

A Proclamation was presented to the Alabama Family Rights Association proclaiming April 19-25th, 2015 as "Parental Alienation Prevention Week" and April 25, 2015 as Parental Alienation Awareness "Bubbles of Love" Day.

BUSINESS:

Council Member Mitchell made the motion to approve the expenditures for the month of February 2015 in the amount of \$690,260: General Fund \$512,931, Payroll \$133,971, Special Funds \$43,358. The motion was seconded by Council Member Coates and the motion carried.

Council Member Davis made the motion to approve the Public Hearing for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) to be held on April 27, 2015 and the right to advertise once a week for four consecutive weeks prior to this date. Council Member Johnson seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Council Member Mitchell made the motion to approve the transfer of the Business License for Retail Beer (Off Premises Only) from Stan Walker, dba DixieExp 1805 to AZIZ Company Incorporated, dba Dixie Express, located at 1014 Highway 72 West. The motion was seconded by Council Member Davis and the motion carried.

Council Member Johnson made the motion to approve the Grant Request to Colbert County Community Development Commission in the amount of \$4,056.86 that was presented by Tammy Holt, Parks and Recreation Athletic Director, to purchase a "Tunnel Batting Cage with accessories". The motion was seconded by Council Member Coates and the motion carried.

With no further business Council Member Davis made a motion to adjourn at 5:30 p.m.; seconded by Council Member Johnson. Motion Carried.
