

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY OF TUSCUMBIA
REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING HELD ON AUGUST 17, 2015
@ 5:30 P.M.

The Tusculmbia City Council met on Monday August 17, 2015 with Billy Shoemaker, Mayor, and Council Members Martha Smith, Robert Mitchell, George Johnson, Sr. Randall Davis and Richard Coates. JoAnn Armstead, City Clerk, Tom Heflin City Attorney, Departments Head Joel Kendrick, Hugh Stanley, Anthony Logan and Luster Echols were also present.

Mayor Billy Shoemaker called the regular scheduled meeting to order @5:30 p.m. Invocation was provided by Hugh Stanley, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by George Johnson, Sr.

Council Member Johnson made a motion to adopt the Minutes of August 3, 2015 (Regular Scheduled Meeting); seconded by Council Member Coates Motion Carried.

REPORTS OF BOARDS

The Civil Service Board met on August 13, 2013 and hired Tanner Mitchell as a Police Officer for the City of Tusculmbia. Employment will begin immediately following drug and health screening. The Civil Service Board also promoted Lt. Stuart Setliff to the position of Captain in the Police Department.

BUSINESS:

Council Member Smith made the motion to approve the expenditures for the month of July 2015 in the amount of \$662,566: General Fund \$356,651; Payroll \$242,607 and Special Funds \$63,308. The motion was seconded by Council Member Davis and the motion was unanimous.

Stormwater Pollution Prevention Ordinance No. 15-0817A

Council Member Davis made a motion to Adopt Ordinance No. 15-0817A, an Ordinance to Establish a Stormwater Pollution Plan. The motion was seconded by Council Member Coates.

Upon Roll Call Vote the following was recorded:

Ordinance Amending Article V- Erosion and Settlement Control of Section 4 of the Code of Ordinances

Council Member Smith made the motion to Adopt Ordinance No. 15-0817B, an Ordinance to Amend Article V – Erosion and Sediment Control of Section 4 Code of Ordinances of the City of Tusculmbia, Alabama. The motion was seconded by Council Member Mitchell.

Upon Roll Call Vote the following was recorded:

Randall Davis, Yes; George Johnson, Yes; Richard Coates, Yes; Billy Shoemaker, Yes; Martha Smith, Yes; Robert Mitchell, Yes. The motion was unanimous.

Council Member Smith made the motion to approve the 3C MPO Agreement with NACOLG, Resolution No. 15-009, authorizing the Mayor to sign the interagency agreement between the Cities of Florence, Killen, Musclev Shoals, Sheffield, Tusculmbia, Colbert Counties, ALDOT and NACOLG. The motion was seconded by Council Member Johnson and the motion was unanimous.

Council Member Coates addressed the speeding on the Commons near Deshler High School Gym. Police Chief Anthony Logan will investigate the problem.

Council Member Johnson made the motion change the Regular Scheduled Council Meeting from September 7, 2015 to Tuesday, September 8, due to Labor Day observation. Council Member Coates seconded the motion and the motion was unanimous.

Hugh Stanley, Public Works Director, provided a written report on Debris Removal from the tornado.

With no further business Council Member Davis made a motion to adjourn at 5:35 p.m.; seconded by Council Member Johnson. Motion Carried.
