Lori Johnson, member of Tuscumbia Bicentennial Committee, provided the mayor and council a handout of the 2019 Bicentennial Schedule of Events and said Heinie Manush Event will take place on April 5-7, 2019 beginning with a Vintage baseball game at Heinie Manush Field.

Council Member Foster made the motion to declare a vacancy for a Laborer in the Public Works Department due to the resignation of Bryant Coates on March 29, 2019; seconded by Council Member Smart. **VOTE:** Yea, 6 Nay, 0

Chief Logan presented the cost of Bullet Proof Vests and External Carriers. The mayor and council advised him to inform them of when the cost exceeds the budget.

The purchase of Pumper Equipment, \$25,000 using 2018 Bond Funds was tabled.

OTHER

Judge Daniel Rosser provided the “Oath of Office” to Officer Eli and his handler Officer John Woodrum. Officer Eli is the police department’s search and rescue dog.

Council Member William Foster would like for the city to have a Dog Park in Spring Park. He would like the cost to see if it is affordable.
