BUSINESS

Council Member Smart made the motion to approve the Expenditures for the month of September 2019 in the amount of \$774,222: General Fund \$499,027, Payroll \$166,983 and Special Funds \$108,212; seconded by Council Member Thompkins. **VOTE:** Yea, 4 Nay, 0 Absent, 2

A cost estimate from Civil Group for resurfacing George Wallace Blvd. between 6th Street and Avalon Avenue was presented to the council for review. If approved by ALDOT the city could receive 100% funding for the resurfacing. The grant will not cover the cost of engineering. Chairperson ProTempore called for a motion to accept proposal; no action taken.

Council Member Thompkins made the motion to accept the costs for the Willie Green Outdoor Lighting and the cost should not exceed \$3,500. Funds will be allocated from the 2018 Warrant Fund. The motion was seconded by Council Member Smart. **VOTE:** Yea, 4 Nay, 0 Absent, 2

Council Member Smart made the motion to declare a vacancy in the Police Department for an Officer due to the resignation of Matthew Senkbeil on October 18, 2019; seconded by Council Member Thompkins. **VOTE:** Yea, 4 Nay, 0 Absent, 2

With no further business Council Member Smart made a motion to adjourn at 5:50 p.m.; seconded by Council Member Thompkins. Motion Carried.
