**DISCUSSION -** “Premium Pay” as allowed for Essential Workers – Resolution No. 21-018

**MOTION -** By Council Member Isom to approve Resolution No. 21-018 that awards Essential Workers Premium Pay as provided under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, for fulltime and part-time employees of the city during the Covid-19 dates of March 13, 2020 thru March 12, 2021 and who remain employed as of this date of adoption. In Summary:

- Fulltime Employees will receive \$6,000 to be disbursed in two equal payments in the amount of \$3,000 each with the 1<sup>st</sup> payment effective immediately and the 2<sup>nd</sup> payment in the amount of \$3,000 to be to be disbursed when the 2<sup>nd</sup> tranche of funds is made available to the city, and
- Part-time Employees will receive \$3,000 to be disbursed in two equal payments in the amount of \$1,500 each with the 1<sup>st</sup> payment effective immediately and the 2<sup>nd</sup> payment in the amount of \$1,500 to be to be disbursed when the 2<sup>nd</sup> tranche of funds is made available to the city;

Seconded by Council Member Smart. VOTE: 6 Yea, 0 Nay

**DISCUSSION -** “Revenue Replacement Funding” -Transfer Funds to the General Fund from the Fiscal Recovery Fund - Resolution No. 21-019

**MOTION -** By Council Member Logan to approve Resolution No. 21-019 that allows for the Replacement of Loss Revenue in amount of \$311,168 to be transferred to the General Fund from the Fiscal Recovery Fund as provided under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021; seconded by Council Member Thompkins. VOTE: 6 Yea, 0 Nay
